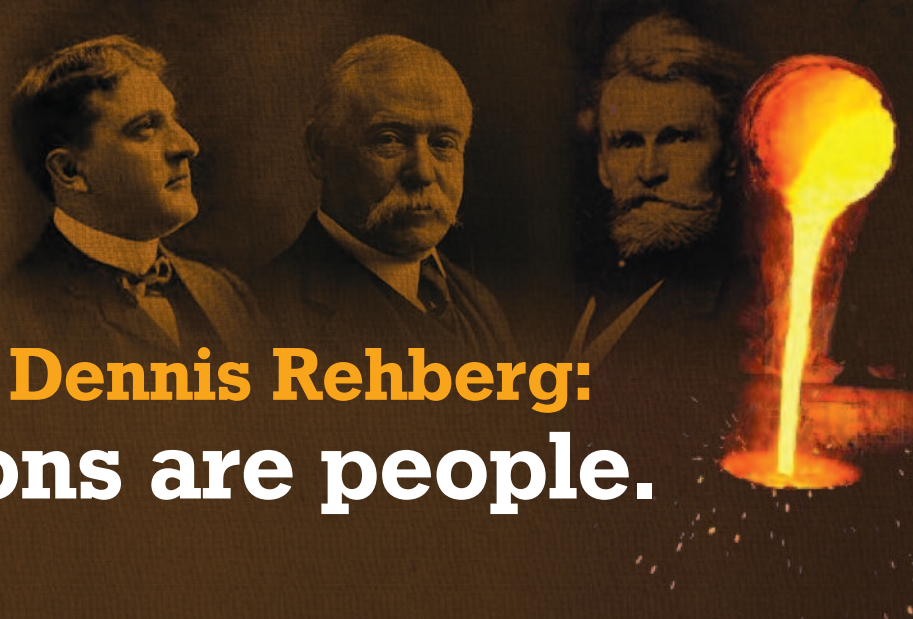


Congressman Dennis Rehberg: Corporations are people.
