LET'S COMPARE:

Dennis Rehberg

- ▶ Sued the City of Billings and the Billings Fire Department
- ▶ Voted against \$800 million for wildland firefighting during a record wildfire season
- ▶ Opposed health benefits for 9/11 heroes through the *James Zagroda 9/11 Health Compensation Act*

Jon Tester

- ▶ Endorsed by Montana firefighters: Montana State Fireman's Association and International Association of Firefighters
- ▶ Delivered necessary firefighting equipment for Montana's firefighting departments and wildland firefighters
- ▶ Supports the right to bargain for fair wages

Bottom line:

Congressman Dennis Rehberg forced Billings taxpayers to pay a \$21,000 legal bill after suing Billings residents and their firefighters after a 2008 fire. The fire didn't damage any homes and only burned brush designated for "planned development" in the Rehberg Ranch Estates subdivision. Rehberg dropped the lawsuit because it had no merit.
