Dennis Rehberg

- ▶ Wants to defund the Libby asbestos treatment passed by Jon Tester
- ▶ Opposes rules to prevent asbestos contamination
- ▶ Opposes guaranteed timber jobs for Libby from Jon Tester's Forest Jobs Act

Jon Tester

- ▶ Secured treatment for victims of Libby asbestos contamination
- ▶ Believes the health of Montana families outweighs corporate greed
- ▶ Authored the landmark Forest Jobs Act to create guaranteed new timber jobs in Libby

Bottom line:

After Libby families fought and suffered for decades from devastating asbestos contamination, Jon Tester secured guaranteed treatment for Libby families who became sick at no fault of their own. Congressman Dennis Rehberg has put corporate greed ahead of Libby families and voted to deny this treatment **six times**.
